

59. Update on Matters Outstanding from Previous Meetings

(i) Poor Lighting on Footpath from Kings Road. To find out who owns the trees overhanging the footpath.

K Matthews informed the Committee that Adrian Sargent from Huntingdonshire District Council has had a look and is now deciding whether to trim or fell the trees. We are presently waiting a decision.

(ii) Zebra Crossing at Station Approach.

Town Clerk has contacted Network Rail requesting that they replace the zebra crossing. To date, he has not received a response.

(iii) Illegal parking on pathways by Market Square.

Town Clerk confirmed that Sgt Kevin Thorne will be attending the next Full Council meeting.

(iv) Traffic Management Plan Update.

Town Clerk confirmed that he, Cllr's Dunford, Wells and Giles had attended a meeting with Nigel Wilson to redraft a more specific plan.

Town Clerk suggested emailing all Committee members the objectives decided at that meeting and asked them to respond to the Clerk with their suggestions/input. He would then email these over to Nigel Wilson and invite him back to the next scheduled committee meeting.

60. Investigation into the Procurement VAS Equipment

The Committee discussed the possibility of purchasing some Speed Monitoring Portable Signs.

Cllr Mrs Johnson proposed that we defer any consideration about purchasing further equipment until the Road Management Plan survey has been completed. And we have detailed information on how to use the equipment that was purchased recently. This was seconded by Cllr Dunford.
