

Play Area - Upgrades and Improvements

Christmas Lights 2017 Working Group

A meeting has been arranged with a supplier on 7th April with both the Town Clerk and Town Development Manager. A working group will be set up after this.

Road Traffic Sign Cleaning

The Operations Team are under a lot of pressure currently, but will fit cleaning of these signs as and when possible.

Display Sign - Eaton Socon Cemetery

The Town Clerk confirmed that the sign had been ordered and will check the progress on the order tomorrow.

Costings for Play Equipment at Shady Walk & Riversmead

A supplier has provided some suggestions on equipment that could be added to these play areas. These will be looked into during April.

Saxon Gate Play Equipment

A supplier will provide design plan which the Town Clerk will present to committee members. This should be available mid-April.

CCTV Wireless

The Town Clerk noted that the plans to implement this are still going ahead within the next six months.

Use of Wardens

The Town Clerk is to receive a package of documents from the Local Council Advisory Service for use by St Neots Town Council.

Cllr Chapman asked for an update on the offer of free trees for the town. The Town Clerk would investigate and email Cllr Chapman on Friday 7th April. At the request of Cllr Chapman this item will also be added on to the Action Sheet.

79. Items from Cllr J Corley

Street lighting - New Street/Tebbutts Road

Cllr Corley has concerns about safety for pedestrians in this area due to a distinct lack of street lighting.

Street lighting - St Mary's Street/Brook Street

Cllr Corley raised his concerns again about safety due to lack of street lighting in this area for pedestrians.

Cllr Chapman as a County Councillor offered to work with Cllr Corley on addressing these issues.
