**Public Participation**

There were no members of the public present.

**1. Election of Vice-Chairman**

**unanimously voted Cllr Usher to vice-chairman.**

**2. Apologies for Absence**

Apologies received from Cllr's Dunford and Chapman. Cllr Wells was absent.

**3. Declarations of Interest**

There were no declarations of interest received.

**4. Minutes**

## 6. LHIF Updates

Nelson Road.

Town Clerk stated there had previously been some confusion whether Nelson Road had been approved. He read aloud the Highways Improvement Initiatives email clarifying that the council had been successful. No further forward this year.

Cllr Mrs S Taylor raised concerns regarding traffic speed/road surfacing around local school areas and suggested that the LHIF funds a speed reduction campaign of one school per year to avoid Highway's requirement of third party funding.

Town Clerk will find out the cost from Highways for each area and bring finding to next meeting.

Action Plan.

Town Clerk is still trying to find out who owns the trees that are overhanging the railway station path. All parties are denying ownership. He has written to the Mayor James Palmer and will chase a reply.

St Neots, Huntingdon and St Ives have formed 'Three Town's Devolution Group' and written to Mayor Palmer as a group for more strength, they have received no response as yet.

Duloe Road.

Town Clerk has not yet heard anything regarding overhanging bushes.

Montagu Road.

Cllr Mrs S Taylor to follow up completion of works on Montagu Road.

Huntingdon Road Scheme.

Town Clerk stated that he has written to the County Council and will send a copy of their reply to councillors to review.
